

Rules for changing voice from active to passive on Tense

Tense	Active	Passive
Simple present	Do, does Eg. They do the work	Is, are + past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work is done by them
Simple past	Did Eg. They did the work	Was, were+ past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work was done by them
Simple future	Will do Eg. They will do the work	Will be + past participle of verb Eg. The work will be done by them
Present continuous	Am, is , are Eg. They are doing the work	Am being, is being, are being+ past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work is being done by them
Past continuous	Was , were Eg. They were doing the work	Was being, were being+ past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work was being done by them
Future continuous	Will be , shall be Eg. They will be doing the work	Will be being, shall be being+ past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work will be being done by them
Present perfect	Have, has + past participle of verb(v3)  Eg. They have done the work	Have been , has been + past participle of verb(v3)  Eg. The work has been done by them
Past perfect	Had+ past participle of verb(v3)  Eg. They had done the work	Had been+ past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work had been done by them
Future perfect	Will have+ past participle of verb(v3) Eg. They will have done the work	Will have been + past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work will have been done by them
Present perfect continuous	Have been doing, has been doing Eg. They will have been doing the work for three hours	Have been being + past participle of verb(v3) Eg. The work has been being done by them for three hours.
Past perfect continuous	Had been doing Eg. They had been doing the work for three hours before we arrived	Had been being + past participle of verb(v3) The work had been being done for three hours before we arrived.
